

# Blanket Lien Worksheet FAQs

On **Monday, June 17**, FHLB Dallas will implement a new blanket lien worksheet as part of a series of technology enhancements slated for 2019. Below are some common questions regarding the upcoming launch of the blanket lien worksheet.

## When will the changes on the blanket lien worksheet take effect?

- The changes to the worksheet will take effect on Monday, June 17, 2019.

## Will the changes impact the processes used by members to view or download the Blanket Lien Worksheet?

- It is possible. Enhancements to the format of the worksheet and the addition/renaming of categories on the worksheet could mean adjustments are needed if you have established processes that extract data from the current version of the report.

## What are the file formats in which the new blanket lien worksheet may be downloaded?

- Members will have a choice to download the worksheet in .txt, .csv, .xml and .pdf formats.

## Does the comparison report reference the last date of change or can a member select a date for comparison?

- Currently it contains the last date of change. But we are working on a future solution.

## Will I be able to access report archives?

- Yes. Members may view them anytime.
